Shelby County Junior Fair Board Candidate Form for Election/Appointment



The Shelby County Junior Fair Board is a premier organization that is well-respected across the state. The board is made up of 28 youth representatives, 2 from each of the 14 townships in Shelby County. The Shelby County Junior Fair Board is known for going above and beyond in helping plan, coordinate and execute the Junior Fair and other 4-H and FFA events throughout the year. It is a fantastic, unmatched learning experience that teaches teens about professionalism, communication, event planning, conflict management, decision-making and more. The Junior Fair Board meets on the third Sunday of the month year around from 6-8 p.m.

To be elected as a member of the Junior Fair Board the nominee must be entering at least the 9th grade in the fall of the year of the election, be an exhibitor in the current year's Shelby County Junior Fair and be eligible to exhibit in said Junior Fair for the duration of the term for which s/he is nominated. They must also submit the following form with all fields completed to the Shelby County OSU Extension Office by the last Friday before fair by the end of the business day (4:30 PM). There are two routes for joining Junior Fair Board:

- (1) <u>Candidate for Election Route (pgs 2-3):</u> This is ONLY for townships with an impending opening. Once an application is submitted, candidates are placed on a ballot for election by their peers. Voting will take place at the Junior Fair Board Headquarters trailer from 12 to 4 p.m. each day of the Junior Fair. Any Junior Fair exhibitor with a valid fair pass for the current year can vote for candidates running for a position in the township they reside in.
- (2) <u>Appointment Route (pg 4):</u> This is for youth who do not live in a township with an opening or youth who run in the election but do not get elected. Appointment interviews will be held the last day of the fair at a time TBA.
