Re: Market Lamb Registration Procedures, Dates, and More

This packet contains information regarding market lamb registration procedures, rules, and dates for the 2023 Shelby County Junior Fair.

If you know of new 4-H or FFA members planning to exhibit market lambs, please pass along these procedures and dates. Information regarding registering market lambs for exhibition at the 2023 Ohio State Fair is also enclosed.

- All market lambs must be under the care of the exhibitor by **Sunday, May 7th, 2023**.
- Market lamb entries are due on *FairEntry* no later than **Thursday, June 1st, 2023, at 4:30 PM**.
- Market lamb mandatory tag-in and optional weigh-in will be held on **Sunday, May 7th, 2023** from 12:00 to 2:00 PM at the Shelby County Fairgrounds.
- ALL livestock exhibitors (market and lactating species) **MUST** attend a Quality Assurance or successfully test out of QA to be eligible to compete at the 2023 Shelby County Junior Fair. Please visit <http://go.osu.edu/shelbyQA> for details about Quality Assurance.

Registration

- If market lambs are **NOT** entered on ***FairEntry* by June 1st, 2023**, exhibitors will **NOT** be permitted to show or sell market lambs at the 2023 Shelby County Junior Fair.
- ***New for 2023:*** Junior Fair Board will take the required photo IDs for market goats and lambs at the mandatory tag-in/optional weigh-in on May 7th, 2023.
 - ***Exhibitors will not be required to upload additional photos of market goats and market lambs.***
 - Exhibitors **ARE** still **REQUIRED** to make those market goat/market lamb entries on ***FairEntry* by June 1st, 2023**.

Important Information

- Lambs must be under one year old and weigh a minimum of 90 lbs. at Fair.
- All male lambs must be castrated and have NO testicular tissue: non-castrated lambs won't be able to show.
- Ewes shown in the Breeding Sheep Show **CANNOT** be shown in Market Lamb/Commercial Ewe Show.
- Commercial Ewes must attend the mandatory tag-in.

DUNF Forms

- Completed Drug Use Notification Forms (DUNF) are required for each animal shown at the Shelby County Junior Fair. Once again, the ODA will be requiring online submission of these forms. More information will be sent out prior to the fair.
- ALL animals MUST be **free** of **any** medication **prior** to submission of the DUNF **before** the animal crosses the scale at weigh-in for the 2023 Shelby County Junior Fair!

Ohio State Fair

- Entries are due online by June 21st, 2023, by 1:00 PM. **Absolutely no late entries will be accepted!**
- You will be required to provide information for either your 4-H County Extension Professional or your FFA advisor.
