OTHER TOPICS OF DISCUSSION FOR IMPROVEMENT (Non-rule changes)

*Yellow highlight was also brought to our attention in 2019

- 1. Better understanding of alpaca species from all parties.
- 2. Post class lists for shows earlier than 24 hours before.
- 3. Beef weigh-in unorganized. No clear understanding of the order.
- 4. Spacing and stall assignments in beef/dairy barns are not equitable.
- 5. Breaking down of cattle classes is done by people who have animals in the show.
- 6. Cattle barn check-out procedures need to be clarified, especially who cleans what (exhibitors, JFB, or SFB).
- 7. Need more help running the hog show. Need people opening gates and helping kids get in the holding pens. Slamming a gate on a pig because they turn around down not solve anything. How the show is ran is a safety issue for kids and pigs.
- 8. Swine holding pen area is so congested people in the crowd cannot watch the show. Parents are coaching kids from the gates.
- 9. Scoresheet and voucher hand-out at pre-fair judging needs streamlined. Too many kids not getting vouchers or scoresheets once they have finished judging.
- 10. Would like to see the buildings free of staples and a fresh coat of paint.
- 11. Make sure skillathon winners know they are being announced and when and where. Top 5 didn't know to be there to receive their award.
- 12. Skillathon needs helpers at stations for younger kids who don't understand answer sheet process.
- 13. Cleanliness of hog/lamb/goat barns needs addressed.
- 14. Cleanliness of wash racks needs addressed.
- 15. Accommodate hog penning requests.
- 16. Creative writing, style revue and modeling event needs to be more organized. It's disorganized and confusing for everyone.
- 17. Rabbit and chicken pens are in bad shape. Boards are warped and uneven, leaving gaps or bumps big enough for animals to get hurt or fall through.
- 18. Fair week 101 booklet or new fair participant 101 session to help new families understand the ins and outs of exhibiting. "You don't know what you don't know."
- 19. Add 4-H youth fun events during fair to encourage mingling.
- 20. Display woodworking and Cloverbud projects in a better area or arrangement.
- 21. FFA building looks dirty. Needs cleaned and more organized, especially banners that are hanging.
- 22. Remember to give photo cards for all pre-fair projects that should get one.
- 23. More peewee classes and Cloverbud opportunities.
- 24. A disability-related event.
