

State Fair Special Interest Update

- OSF non livestock judging dates: July 28-August 8 (original OSF dates)
- Monday, July 26 will be deadline to register delegates via 4HOnline.
- No Clovertowne
- All project judging will be in the Lausche Building (Youth Center, where we typically have judging).
- Some judging events lend themselves better for virtual.
- Will not be offering International Day or PETPALS.
- No "skills" events (woodworking, cake decorating, scrapbooking). Woodworking members can bring the project they made at home. Accommodations will need to be made for those with large projects.
- Everyone will be judged through one-on-one interviews with a judge.
- There will be no Fashion Revue.
- The county participation schedule has been changed. Some county times have changed as well as registrations will be every 30 minutes instead of hourly. The last registration time will be 3:30 p.m.
- Will not be able to have in-person awards ceremony. No plans for virtual award ceremony.
- 4-H members will be given door entrance assignments based on their project. This information will be included in the participant letters.
- There will be no admission charge to come to state fair since it isn't open to the general public but may be a parking charge per vehicle (details TBD).
- 1 parent per kid allowed to attend; will have different parent and participant waiting areas. 4-H members will be judged then allowed to return to their cars.
- State fair 4-H guidebook pages will be updated soon to include the changes.
- For those families uncomfortable with in-person judging, there will be a virtual option for OSF judging.
