

SHELBY CO. 4-H PLANNING GUIDE FOR PRE-FAIR JUDGING

July 20-24, 2020 at the Beige Building

Arrival:

- Please arrive **no earlier** than 10 minutes before your scheduled judging time.
- Park in the grassy area (typically the camper lot) between the new restrooms and the Secretary's Office.
- Enter the Beige Building through the east garage door (entrance closest to the 4-H Booth Building).
- Sign in with the Junior Fair Board (blue polo shirts) and follow their instructions.

Exhibitors & Guests:

- We ask that guests be limited to two people maximum (not including the exhibitor) when possible. We realize there are cases in which this may not be feasible, but do please ask that a good faith effort is made to minimize the number of people in attendance.
- Recognize that some individuals may be at a higher risk of serious illness if they develop COVID-19. We discourage high-risk individuals from attending in an effort to reduce their exposure to COVID-19.
- According to the *Ohio 4-H Planning Guide for In-Person Meetings & Events* (go.osu.edu/shelbyreturntoinperson), face masks are expected to be worn at all 4-H in-person meetings and events. Face masks refer to disposable procedure masks or cloth face coverings, not surgical or N-95 respirators. They should fit snugly around the mouth and nose and be worn appropriately to be effective. Remember – it is possible to have COVID-19, not exhibit any symptoms and transmit the virus to others. Wearing a face mask is a measure to protect others.
- Monitor your health! Be alert for symptoms: fever, cough, shortness of breath. Do not attend pre-fair activities if you or anyone living in your household is experiencing symptoms associated with the COVID-19 or any other communicable illness. Follow CDC/ODH guidance if symptoms develop.

Social Distancing & Sanitation:

- Consider waiting outside (weather permitting) until the exhibitor's name is called to see the judge.
- Maintain six feet of distancing between individuals whenever feasible. The floors will be marked to indicate appropriate social distancing techniques. Look for the bright green tape!
- Bring your own chair to sit in, if possible.
- Wash your hands often, with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after touching any frequently used item or surface.
- Avoid touching your face or others in attendance.
- Sneeze or cough into a tissue or the inside of your elbow.

Virtual Opportunities:

- All exhibitors are invited to have their judging done via Zoom if they so choose. Set judging times will remain the same. We will simply set a computer up with Zoom in the same space the exhibitor would have occupied if they were physically present. Exhibitors being judged virtually will still be eligible for placing and awards. We also plan to livestream awards at the end of each day.
