### Shelby County 4-H Project Aid Fund

Funds to support Shelby County 4-H members with their projects. Support shall include, but not limited to, the purchase of livestock, housing, tack, feed, bedding, books, supplies etc. Awardees shall be selected base on an application process administered by the Shelby County 4-H Advisory Board, in collaboration with and final approvals from the Shelby County Extension Personnel.

Eligibility – Current 4-H members only, members must be in good standing with their club and with Ohio State 4-H and are able to demonstrate an understanding of the loan process and have a financial need for the loan.

Deadline--All forms must be filled out completely and returned to the extension office by April 1<sup>st</sup>.

Awardee notification—Announcements of the recipient(s) of the loans for the year will be made by April 15th.

#### Loan amounts available:

| Species         | Minimum-Maximum |
|-----------------|-----------------|
| Cattle          | \$100-300       |
| Hogs            | \$100-200       |
| Sheep           | \$100-200       |
| Goats           | \$100-200       |
| Rabbits/Poultry | \$25-100        |

Interest rate: No interest rate will be charged on this loan.

Loan repayment: Loans must be repaid to the fund at <https://www.giveto.osu.edu/makeagift/> search fund number 316805 and set up a gift detail equal to your loan amount. Repaying loans back into the fund will allow future 4-H members to receive financial aid.
